In the Name of God Amen I Edward Curtis of Stratton Saint Margaret in the County of Wilts Yeoman do this second day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight make publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner following, that is to say, I give to my sister Ann Kemble and to my nephew Richard Kemble a legacy or sum of ten pounds a piece the same to be paid them by my Executrix hereinafter named at the end of six months next after my decease all the rest residue and remainder of my real and personal estate and effects of every sort and kind which I shall die possessed of or entitled to either in possession reversion remainder or expectancy or otherwise howsoever (Subject to the payment of my just debts the above legacies and my funeral and testamentary expences) I give devise and bequeath unto Hannah Hedges who is now living with me as my housekeeper to hold the same to her the said Hannah Hedges her heirs Exors admors and assigns according to the different natures and qualities thereof to and for her own use and benefit absolutely and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint the said Hannah Hedges sole Executrix of this my Will hereby revoking all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written Edward Curtis
