The Survey was commissioned by Miss Catherine Tylney Long, of Draycot Cerne, the landowner. She inherited the Estate in 1805 when she was aged 16.

The Survey is similar in format to the Tithe Maps and Schedules, with locations on the map cross-referenced with a schedule.

The 1808 Survey uses different numbers from the 1839 Tithe to identify plots of land and buildings.

There is one map of both villages, with two inserts listing the names of the principal tenants in each village.

Names are categorised as either 'Occupiers' or 'Lifeholders'

There is also a 'Reference Book', which provides details of the landholdings and other information, for each tenant, by village.

Pages 2-13 are blank. Draycot Cerne is pp. 14-51; pp. 52-57 are blank; Sutton Benger is pp. 58-142

Transcriber's descriptions or estimates of location are shown below by comparing the Reference Book (Schedule), the 1808 Map and today's map

Any use of italics in the transcription is for text not in the original; eg, 'about 20 plots, over 28 acres' is a precis of what is actually in the schedule.

The original used superscript for names; eg Jas for James. These have been written in full in this transcription.

This transcription has not included all details of the names or size of plots (acreage, etc), nor all details of the 'state in 1808', such as 'pasture' or 'arable' etc

The map has some over-writing in red: for example, 'Glebe Lands' is written in red in the relevant areas, especially across the area of land NE of Sutton Benger, by the Avon

The words 'Sutton Common Meads' are written in red across a large area of land between Sutton Benger and the Avon, south of the main road.

Plots in the Common Mead have the tenants' names added in red.

The words 'A Detached (sic) Part of Draycot Parish' are written in red across the appropriate plots between Sutton Lane and the Avon, in the SE corner of the Parish.

The words 'Crip and go' are written on certain plots, as repeated in the Schedule. The Transcriber thought this was 'clip and go' or 'crop and go' but it seems to be 'crip'.

The word 'crip'; is not found in the OED, so the transcriber has left it as 'clip'.

There is also text for 'First Day's Mowth ...Fourth Day's Mowth' on appropriate plots, as referenced in the Schedule.
