His Wife. Born at Meerut N.W.P. India 1th September 1863 Died at Sutton Mandeville 18th December 1903 The souls of the faithful are in the hand of God.</p>

Also In Memory of the Revd. James Hibberd, A.B. 38 years Rector of this Parish Who died March 29th 1831, Aged 64 Years. He lived respected, and died Deservedly lamented</p>
