John TURNER June, 1847

An Inquest was held by Mr Wilson, on Monday last, at Plaitford, on the body of Isaac Petty, an elderly man, who was found dead in his bed on that morning without previous illness.-

Another inquest was also held by the same Coroner on Tuesday, at Sutton Mandeville, on the body of John Turner, the clerk of the parish, who was found dead in his bed under similar circumstances on the previous morning.

Verdict in each case, *Died by the visitation of God.*
