Sutton Mandeville 1850-1899

1868

At Hindon petty sessions. Samuel Johnson, of Sutton Mandeville, was apprehended on a warrant for abusing and threatening John Gray, of Sutton Mandeville, on the 5th July last. Complainant said that defendant stripped to fight him and abused him on the day in question, and also threatened to kill him. Johnson was bound by recognizance in £10 to keep the peace for six months.
