At Sutton Mandeville, by the Rev. John Wyndham, Mr. W. Salmon, of Broad Chalke, to Sarah, third daughter of Mr. Stone, of the former place. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 19 January 1850**

1853

On the 12th instant, at St. Paul's Church, Covent Garden, London, James Thomas, youngest son of Mr. Thomas Foyale, of Sutton Mandeville, yeoman, to Eliza, eldest daughter of the late Mr. Henry Frederick Leah, silversmith, of Shaftesbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 16 April 1853**

On the 31st ultimate, at Orcheston St. Mary Wilts., by the Rev. S. Dendy, the Rev. John Wyndham, Rector of Sutton Mandeville, in the same county, to Caroline Delia, only daughter of Edward Kielley, Esq., St. John's, Newfoundland. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 4 June 1853**

1857

1867
