



Sutton Veny St. Leonard's Benefaction Board

JOSEPH DEW and ANTHONY LONG bequeath to the Rector, churchwardens and overseers, the sum of EIGHTY POUNDS (in Trust) the Interest to be expended and laid out in the purchase of Cloth and Linen, and distributed on the Twenty first day of December annually to the most deserving poor not receiving Parochial relief.

ALSO MR^s MARY LONG in the year 1807 bequeathed to the Rector, Churchwardens, and Overseers, the sum of FIFTY POUNDS (in Trust) the Interest to be expended and laid out in the purchase of Cloth and Linen, and distributed on the Twenty first day of December annually to the most deserving poor not receiving Parochial relief.

WHICH sums together with FIFTY SIX POUNDS, subscribed by the principal Inhabitants of the Parish of Sutton Veny have been expended (except Fifteen Pounds) in the Purchase, erection, and repair of Three Freehold Cottages in the said Parish in the year of our Lord 1825, the Rents of which are to be applied as above directed.
