



Sutton Veny St. Leonard's Churchyard Burial Plot Details

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This summary of the tomb stones was carried out during the winter 1983 – 84. Many engravings are badly worn. A question mark follows any entry where the legibility was obviously in doubt.

Grave numbers refer to the plan drawn by D. Norris in March 1983.

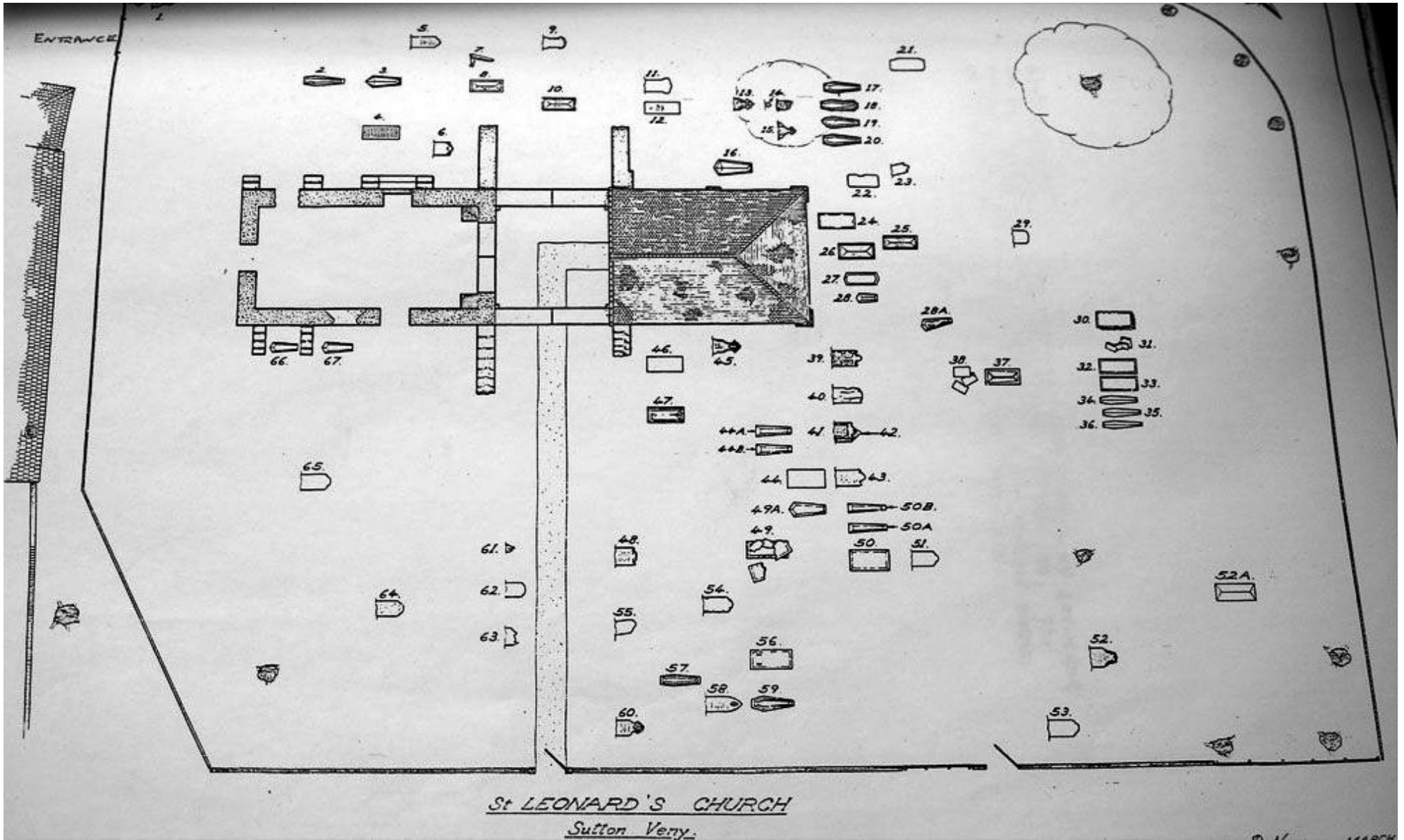
