Hinton	John	<p>Sacred to the memory of JOSIAS HINTON, Gentleman late of this Parish who died the 16th of June 1775, Aged 53 Years and of MARY HINTON his Wife who died the 8th of March 1795, Aged 75 Years also to the memory of MARY HINTON daughter of the above named JOSIAS HINTON and MARY his wife she departed this life the 25th of February 1776 Aged 24 Years Their remains lie interred near this place</p>
Hinton	William	<p>Near this place are deposited the remains of WILLIAM HINTON ESQ^R. Late of Bishopstrow, in this County, who departed this life the 18th of January 1816, Aged 74 Years ANN HINTON, wife of WILLIAM HINTON ESQ^R. died 3rd June 1776. Aged 34 Years. She was Daughter and Heiress of JOHN LOADER, Late of Berwick St. James. In the County, Gentleman and married first ROBERT POWELL, of Stapleford, In the County, Gentleman Her body lies interred in Bishopstrow Church Yard ELIZABETH HINTON wife of WILLIAM HINTON ESQ^R. died 30th September 1815, Aged 66 Years. She was Daughter and only surviving child of JOSIAS HINTON, late of this Parish. Gentleman, and MARY his wife, her remains are interred near this place This Monument is erected as a tribute of affection and respect, to his memory by ANN HINTON, his only child.</p>

He died at Bellary in the East Indies on the 17th June 1815 Aged 54 Years MARY MARTIN his Widow (Daughter of the Revd. BROUNCKER THRING D.D. And MARY BAYLY his Wife) Who died at Bishopstrow in this County on the 17th of February 1819 Aged 31 Years and lies interred on the Vault beneath having issue one Son and a Daughter</p>
Neale	Sarah	<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred to the memory of SARAH NEALE who died 19th April 1857, Aged 52 Years and of STEPHEN NEALE who died February 1st 1869 Aged 68 Years and of STEPHEN who died 1st July 1855. Aged 16 Years CHARLOTTE ANN, (Wife of A.C. Murton.) who died 29th September 1862 Aged 25 Years</p>

Paine	Joseph	<p style="text-align: center;">Near this place are deposited the remains of the Reverend Doctor JOSEPH PAINE of the Kingdom of Ireland late Rector of this Parish Gentleman [remainder faint]</p>
Parham	Mary Ann	<p style="text-align: center;">In memory of MARY ANN, wife of WILLIAM PARHAM who died April 5th 1852, Aged 46 Years and the above named WILLIAM PARHAM who died July 17th 1867 Aged 70 Years. also of their children AUSTIN, who died March 30th 1840, Aged 5 Weeks. JOHN THOMAS, who died Sept. 20th 1852, Aged 14 Years, and ALBERT HENRY Commander of the ship "Norfolk" who died January 27th 1875 Aged 35 Years. Buried at Melbourne, Australia. HENRIETTA PARHAM died August 26th 1913, Aged 69.</p>

EDWARD TAYLOR A.M. who was Rector of this Parish 32 Years He died Decr. 15th 1763 Aged 69 He was descended from an antient Family in Lancashire and was educated at Brazen Nose College in Oxford There he was early distinguished by his abilities as a Scholar which afterwards renderd him an ornament to his Profession. He married ANN Daughter of ANTHONY LEYBORNE of Oceton in Yorkshire Efq^r.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">By whom he had Issue three Sons EDWARD, WILLIAM & SHIPPEN who died at Lisbon and two Daughters FRANCES, who lies buried in the same Vault and ANN This Monument was in due Gratitude, erected to his Memory by his eldest Son EDWARD TAYLOR Eq^r.</p>

Many Years Rector of this Parish His Death was deeply lamented by all with whom he stood connected by the Functions of his sacred Office or by the Ties of social intercourse He died September 25th 1812 Aged 61 Years Also BROUNCKER CROWCH Son of the above Revd. BROUNCKER THRING He died the 3rd March 1806 Aged nine Years</p>
