Granary and Stable at Ashbys

Location – Tytherington Village, Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 11 September, 1968

Stable and granary, c1800.

Rubblestone with brick dressings, pyramidal tiled roof. Two-storey, 3-windowed. Central stable door with segmental arch, triangular-headed windows either side. Square planked loading door over, flanked by two small bull's eye openings. Attached to right is integral single storey store shed with planked door and circular window to curved wall.

Interior retains upper floor, used as cowshed during C20.
