Everett	Joseph	To the Glory of God and in memy of JOSEPH EVERETT of Greenhill who died Oct. 5 1865 ...
Everett	Leonard William Dawson	To the Glory of God and in Affectionate Memory of LEONARD WILLIAM DAWSON EVERETT Captain. The Welch Regt. Killed by a Lion in Rhodesia in October 18 <sup>th</sup> 1911, while employed on the Anglo-Belgian Frontier Commission Aged 36 years Erected by his Brother Officers
Everett	Leonard William Dawson	All praise and thanksgiving to God for the pure and steadfast life of his faithful Soldier and servant LEONARD WILLIAM DAWSON EVERETT (Captain Welch Regt.) ninth son of the Rev. A.J. Everett late Rector of this parish born Aug: 15 <sup>th</sup> 1875: entered into Life Oct: 18 <sup>th</sup> 1911 and in ever loving remembrance of him his death was caused by injuries received from a wounded lion at Tumba N.E. Rhodesia Africa “we sent you out with mourning and weeping but God will give you to us again with joy and gladness foe ever”

Hobbs	Peter Graham	<p>In proud and loving memory  <b>PETER GRAHAM HOBBS</b>  Royal Horse Artillery Brigade Major  7<sup>th</sup> Armoured Division Eighth Army  killed in Action on 27<sup>th</sup> May 1942  near Bir Hacheim Libya aged 31  and his brother  <b>WILLIAM PAUL HOBBS M.B.E.</b>  Lieut. Colonel Commanding 111<sup>th</sup> Field  Regt. Royal Artillery Eighth Army  killed in Action on 12<sup>th</sup> May 1943  near Enfidaville Tunisia aged 29  They were lovely and pleasant in their lives</p>
Powell	Geo. Francis Sydenham	<p>In memory of the Rev.  <b>GEO FRANCIS SYDENHAM POWELL B.A.</b>  Rector of the Parish at the  time of the Building of this Church who died  Febry. 16<sup>th</sup> 1888 the Inhabitants  of this Village erect this tablet  in grateful remembrance of his  earnest work and loving sympathy  during his 33 years ministry  amongst them</p>
Thornton	Cyril Minshull	<p>In  Loving Memory  of  <b>CYRIL MINSHULL THORTON, F.R.C.S.</b>  of Greenhill, in this Parish  Born May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1870  youngest son (by his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife)  of the late Richard N. Thornton  of 98 Portland Place,  Justice of the Peace  Lieut: Imperial Yeomanry, S. Africa 1900,  Captain Royal Wilts Imperial Yeomanry  who did of dysentery  while on a hunting expedition  at Mphiras Village  near Mpika, N.W. Rhodesia,  and was buried there by his carriers  on the 9<sup>th</sup> September 1908.  “The night is dark and I am far from home lead thou me on”</p>
