This is the last Will and Testament of me William ffrancis Long of Sutton Veny Wilts Gentleman which hereby revoking all former Wills I do make publish and declare as follows I give and devise unto my dear Wife Elizabeth Tizard Long All those my six Cottages or Tenements at Hobbs Doat with the gardens thereto belonging called Kingmans and my Garden late Colliers at Sutton Veny aforesaid To hold unto and to the use of my said Wife Elizabeth Tizard Long her heirs and assigns for ever I also give unto my Wife Elizabeth Tizard Long all my household goods furniture linen plate Wines and Liquors and all other my Estates and hereditaments real or personal of what nature or kind soever and that she do receive all moneys due to my Estate and pay just debts and any funeral and testamentary expences And I do make and appoint my said Wife Elizabeth Tizard Long to be Executor of this my last Will and Testament And I declare that the receipts of my said Executor shall be good and sufficient discharge In Witness whereof I the said Testator William ffrancis Long have to this my last Will and Testament contained in one sheet of paper set my hand and seal the fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one William ffrancis Long.
