



Court Case - Hiscock & Wright v Burt

Wilts Quarter Sessions Hiscock v Wright, Swallowcliffe, v William Burt, Harwood, Ansty, Wilts.

Claim £4.14s 3d.

Mr. Jackson for plaintiffs.

Mr. Stevens, clerk to Mr. Woolley, said defendant, although denying owing the money, had offered to pay 1s. a week. Mr. Jackson read a letter from Mr. Parmiter, defendant's employer, denying liability.

Defendant, sworn, declared that he had paid plaintiffs for all the goods he had ever purchased of them.

Mr. Jackson thereupon applied that the case should be adjourned, to admit of the attendance of one of the plaintiffs. His Honour granted the adjournment.
