September 10th at Ladysmith, South Africa, killed in Action, John Fox Harper, Lieutenant, Imperial Yeomanry, fifth son of the Rev. Richard Harper of Wimborne, Dorset, and formerly Superintendent Minister at the Bath Road, Wesleyan Church, Swindon, aged 23 years. **Swindon Advertiser and North Wilts Chronicle, 20 September 1901**

### 1903

October 1, at the English Church, Paris, Sydney Thomas, fifth son of R. H. & S. Garrett, of Swindon to Marie Louise, only child of Madame Lecourieux, of Paris. **North Wilts Herald, 9 January 1903**

October 1, at Brompton Hospital, Charles Allen, second son of the late William Day of Swindon, aged 24 years. **North Wilts Herald, 9 January 1903**

### 1905
