



Funeral of Mr. G. Stanford

The funeral service took place on Wednesday, at St. John's Church, Swindon, of Mr. George Stanford, late of Beatrice Street, Swindon who as recorded in another page, died at the home of his daughter, York House, Abingdon. Mr. Stanford worked in the G. W. R. Works F. Shop for 42 years and on retirement, two years ago, went to Abingdon to live.

He was the proud possessor of the Royal Humane Society's certificate presented to him in 1891 for diving into the canal at Challow fully dressed and rescuing a woman who had fallen in.
