Birth Registration for Mary Annie Booth was the September Quarter of 1857 in the Highworth Registration District.

Birth Registration of her brother Thomas Chantler Booth was record in the March Quarter of 1859 also in the Highworth Registration District.

The 1861 Census at Westcott Place, Swindon records:-Mary Anne Booth, daughter, 2, born in Swindon, with parents, William, 30, a fitter and turner, and Ellen, 25, both born in Bury, Lancashire, and brother Thomas C., 2, and an infant sister, just 3 days old.

The 1871 census at New Swindon records:-William Booth, 40, an engine turner, Mary, 36, both born in Bury, Lancashire, Mary Annie, 13, a scholar, Thomas, 12, Ada, 10, Minnie, 5, Alfred, 8, Elizabeth 1. Children all born in New Swindon.

The 1881 at Wellington Street, Swindon records:-

Mary A. Booth, 23, Dressmaker, her parents, William Booth, 50, engine fitter, and Mary E., 45, her brother and sisters, Ada M., 19, dressmaker, Alfred C., 17, railway clerk, Minnie S., 15, and Elizabeth E., 11.

The 1891 at Percy Street, St. Pancras, London records:-Annie M. Booth, 31, a professional Nurse, registered, as boarding with Catherine J. Wood, another professional Nurse, registered, and also boarding are 12 other registered nurses.
