Henry Goodfellow, Edward Lever, and George Penny, labourers of Teffont Magna, were summoned for trespassing in pursuit of rabbits on land in the occupation of Mr. James Flower, of Chilmark, on July 14th.

Defendants pleaded guilty.

Mr. Flower's keeper deposed to seeing defendants in Mr. Flower's warren at about 9 p.m. throwing at the rabbits. Goodfellow had a rabbit in his possession. A fine of 2s. and costs 9s. together was imposed on each defendant.
