### Summary of Objects

To give practical form to the comradeships which grew and developed in the Burma Campaign.

Membership is restricted to men and women who are entitled to wear the Burma Star, or the "Burma" clasp to the Pacific Star.

Associate Membership is restricted to those who served in S. E. Asia during the 1939-45 War but did **not** earn the Burma Star. They have the same privileges as Burma Star members except that they are not entitled to vote at Meetings concerned with the conduct of Association affairs, nor are they eligible for help from the National Welfare Fund. Application for Associate Membership presumes acceptance of these restrictions.


