



Early Stuart Tradesmen in South Tidworth

Fines at Market Sessions, 1607

Ambresbury and Alderbury Hundreds: Estreats of fines made before John Beale in the market sessions held at Ambrosbury, 13 July 1607.

Of Richard Davers of Gommelton, for not appearing as a juror, 20d.;

Roger Brooke of Ambrosbury, victualler, for not appearing with his bread of all kinds for weighing with the standards, 3s. 4d.;

William Blake, George Acreaman, John Whateley, all of the same, severally for not appearing with their weights and measures for examination with the standards, 3s. 4d. Each;

the inhabitants of West Wellowe and the inhabitants of Tidworth South and Moyle, for the like, 6s. 8d each.
