



## Early Stuart Tradesmen in North Tidworth

### Informations Relating to Wiltshire Lodged in the Court of Exchequer in the Reign of James I

William Pitnam of Tidworth, for engrossing wheat at £4. per acre, rye, barley, beans and pease at £3 and oats at 40s an acre; information by Henry Smart of London, yeoman, 6 December 1614.

Robert Baylye of Tedworth, for engrossing wheat at 50s. per quarter, rye, barley and malt at 40s. and oats, beans and pease at 30s.; information by John Yardley of London, yeoman, 12 February 1617

George Hunt of Collingborne Ducis, clerk, for illegally farming lands at North Tydworth of a yearly value of £126; information by Nicholas Kente of Winterborne Dauntsey, yeoman, 11 February 1618
