bequeath unto my Brother in Lawe James Cooper whome I doe hereby make my ffull and whole Executor of this my last Will and Testamt And I doe hereby Revoake all former Wills and Wills by me made whatever In Witnesse whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and Seale the Twenty ffifth Day of November Anno Dm one Thousand Seaven Hundred and Eight
