be chargeable and Charged on and issuing and payable out of my Leasehold Farm called Hook March situate in the Parish of Semley in the County of Wilts to be paid half Yearly I also give to my beloved Wife Mary Gray one half of my Household Goods save and except the Dairy Utensils I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Gray the Sum of Fifty Pounds I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary now the Wife of John Combes the sum of Fifty pounds I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Gray the Sum of Fifty Pounds to be paid within three Months after the Decease of my beloved Wife Mary Gray And as to all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate Whatsoever and Wheresoever And of what Nature Kind or quality soever the same may be and not herein before given and disposed of I do hereby give and bequeath the same being all Personal Property unto my Son John Gray to and for his own use and benefit And I do hereby make ordain constitute and appoint my Son the said John Gray sole executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set and subscribed my hand and seal the day and year first above written *James Gray*
