



## **Inquest Report on James Gardiner**

Inquests before Mr. Coroner Sylvester:

At Trowbridge, on James Gardiner, aged 61 years. The deceased was employed at Mr. Gouldsmith's factory, and went to his work on the morning of the 4th ult. He sent James Hayward to procure him some tea, and on his return he found him lying back in his chair. The deceased suffered from dilation of the cavities of the heart and died from fatal syncope.

Verdict, "Died from Visitation of God."
