This is the last Will and Testament of me Daniel Strang of Trowbridge in the County of Wilts Dyer I give and devise unto my sister Rosamond Webber Wife of William Webber of Trowbridge aforesaid Dyer aforesaid All my freehold Messuages Lands Tenements Hereditaments and Premises whatsoever and wheresoever situate To hold the same unto her my said sister Rosamond Webber her heirs and assigns for ever But subject to any Mortgage and Mortgages that may be thereon at the time of my decease I give and bequeath unto Ann Hilperton in the said County of Wilts Spinster the sum of One hundred pounds to be paid to her by my Executors hereinafter named within six Calendar Months next after my decease All the Rest Residue and Remainder of my Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature or kindsoever I give and bequeath unto John Todhunter and Philip Sanston of the City of London Dry Salters Upon trust that they the said John Todhunter and Philip Sanston and the survivor of them and the Executors and Administrators of such survivor Do and shall with all convenient speed after my decease call in sell dispose of and convert into Money such part of my said Personal Estate and Effects as shall not consist of Money and with and out of the Monies which shall come to their or his hands or hand pay satisfy and discharge all my just debts funeral and testamentary Expences and do and shall stand possessed of the residue of the Monies which shall remain after answering the purposes aforesaid Upon the trusts following that is to say upon trust to pay and equally divide the same between the Children of my said sister

Rosamond Webber the share or shares of such of them as shall not have attained the age of twenty one Years to be placed out at Interest either on Government or freehold Security and applied for and towards their maintenance and education Provided and I do direct that the share or shares to which the married Daughters of my said sister will be entitled shall not be subject or liable to the debts control or interference of their Husbands But that their receipts alone notwithstanding their Coverture shall be sufficient discharges And I appoint the said John Todhunter and Philip Sanston Executors of this my Will Provided and it is my Will that the said John Todhunter and Philip Sanston and the survivor of them and the executors and administrators of such survivor shall and may at all days hereafter deduct out of all or any part of my trust Monies All such Costs Charges and Expences as they or any of them shall pay sustain or be put unto for or on account of performing or in the execution of the trusts contained in this my will and that they or either of them shall not be answerable or accountable for the acts deeds neglects or defaults of the other of them but each for his own acts and defaults only In Witness whereof I the said Daniel Strang the Testator have to this my Will contained in one sheet of Paper set my hand and seal the twenty seventh day of May One thousand eight hundred and thirty one \_ *Daniel Strang*
