At Wilts Assizes three prisoners were capitally convicted, and received sentences of death, viz. J. Reeves, for stealing a mare from Chiseldon, the property of Mr. J. Smith; J. Farmer, for a burglary in the house of Mrs. Crook, at Tytherton-Lucas; and R. Smith, for braking open the house of W. Lawrence, at Alderbury. They were all reprieved before the Judges left the city.
