Wiltshire Quarter Sessions. Before Mr. Merewether. William Kite, for stealing six fowls at Upton Lovell - Two months imprisonment. **Salisbury & Wiltshire Journal, 15 January 1853**

Trials of Prisoners. Yesterday Second Court Before Lord Edmond Fitzmaurice (Chairman), and other Magistrates. Assault at Upton Lovell: Another Lenient Sentence. George Ashley, 39, labourer, for assaulting Emily Florence Hibbert, 11 years of age, at Upton Lovell, on July 3rd, was sentenced to two months' hard labour. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 18 October 1888**

Warminster Police Court, Friday Before Captain Helme and the Rev. W. Hickman. John Roberts, a tramp, was brought up on remand charged with stealing a pair of boots, value 5s., the property of Alfred Rowe, of Upton Lovell, on the 25th August, and sentenced to a month's imprisonment. He was further charged with stealing a quantity of articles, value 4s. 6d., from the house of George Northover, at Whaddon, but the case was dismissed. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 5 September 1889**
