### **MARRIAGES**

On Thursday was married, at Wilton, Christopher Ingram, Esq. of Upton Lovel, to Moss Geary, of Wilton, daughter of the late Mr Andrew Geary, of Milford, near this city.

(*Salisbury and Winchester Journal* – Monday 21 May 1810)

On Tuesday last was married, at Langley Burrell, in this county, Mr James Smith, of Upton Lovell, to Miss Susannah Mustee (Mustec/Mustoc?), of Langley Burrell.

(*Salisbury and Winchester Journal* – Monday 19 June 1815)

On Sunday the 22d inst. was married by the Rev. Wm. Poticary, Mr Roger Rebbeck, of Knook, to Ann Alford, youngest daughter of William Alford, of Upton Lovell, in this county.

(*Salisbury and Winchester Journal* – Monday 30 August, 1819)

Saturday se'nnight was married at Upton Lovell, in this county, Mr Charles Allford, higgler, to Miss Ann Emm, of the former place.

(*Salisbury and Winchester Journal* – Monday 23 February, 1824)

On Monday the 9<sup>th</sup> inst. was married at Stroud, in the county of Gloucester, by the Rev. John Williams, D. D. Mr John Penny, of Upton Lovell, in this county, to Harriet, daughter of the late Mr Christopher Hinwood, of Codford St. Mary.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 23 February, 1824)*

Thursday last was married at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. Wm. Roles, Mr John Grant, landlord at the King's Head, Chittern St. Mary, in this county, to Miss Elizabeth Smith, of the former place.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 1 March, 1824)*

Married – At Boyton, R. Smith, esq. of Upton Lovell, to Charlotte, daughter of Rd. Withers, esq. of Corston-house.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 26 August, 1824)*

Married – On Wednesday last at Shrewton, by the Rev. William Roles, A.M. rector of Upton Lovell, in this county, Mr H. L. Tovey, surgeon, of Maddington, to Martha, eldest daughter of Charles Howard Wansborough, esq. of Shrewton House; and at the same time and place, Mr Thomas Ogden Stevens of Salisbury, to Harriet, second daughter of John Wansborough, esq. of Shrewton Lodge.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 1 December, 1825)*

On Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup> inst. was married, by the Rev. Wm. Roles, Mr Thomas Bennett, of Stockton, to Frances, youngest daughter of Mr Raxworthy, of Upton Lovell.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 30 September, 1826)*

Lately was married, at Upton Lovell, Miss Anna Penny, youngest daughter of Mr Thos. Penny, of Upton Lovell, to Mr Isaac Humphry, of Stockton.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 30 June, 1828)*

Married, a short time since, at Steeple Langford, by the Rev. Mr Seagrim, Mr James Dyer, of Upton Lovell, to Miss Ann Mitchell, of the former place.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 20 February, 1832)*

Married – At Warminster, by the Rev. Wm. Dalby, on the 11<sup>th</sup> inst, William Brown, esq. of Upton Lovell, to Mary, eldest daughter of the late Christopher Ingram, esq. of Stapleford.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 21 November, 1833)*

Married – On Monday July 1, at Upton Lovell, Wilts, by the Rev. Vaughan, John Ingram, esq., to Elizabeth Sayer, widow of Mr Sayer, of Portsmouth, and daughter of the late Mr Thomas Hale, of Coombe, Wilts.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 11 July, 1839)*

Married, March 20, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. John Vaughan, LL.B, Rector, Jane, fourth dau. Of Mr James Smith, of that place, to Mr Samuel Wm. Worssam, second son of Mr John Worssam, timber-merchant, late of Wellington Wharf, London. Shortly after the ceremony the happy couple bade a farewell to their assembled friends, and proceeded *en route* to Bristol, having previously engaged a berth in that fine ship the “Arabian” destined for Australia.

Married, Nov. 27, at St. John’s Church, Bedminster, by the Rev. H. G. Eland, Thos. Raxworthy, Esq., of Upton Lovell, Wilts, to Fanny, relict of W. H. Booth, Esq., late of Bristol.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 30 November, 1844)*

Married, Jan. 8, at Berwick St. Leonard, Wilts, by the Rev. W. Bedford, Thomas, eldest son of Mr Wm. Ford, carpenter and builder, of Upton Lovell, to Mary, youngest daughter of Mr Wm. Blandford, farmer, of the above place.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 17 January, 1846)*

Married - Jan. 17, at the Old Church, Trowbridge, Wilts, Samuel, the 4<sup>th</sup> son of the late Mr James Smith, of Upton Lovell, Wilts, to Catherine Bradley, widow of Mr J. Bradley, of Rochester.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 25 January, 1849)*

Married – June 13<sup>th</sup>, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. W. Grey, Mr Martin, of Salterton, to Mary, 2<sup>nd</sup> daughter of Mr Raxworthy, of the former place.

# DEATHS

On the 16<sup>th</sup> inst. Died the Rev. John Crouch, Rector of Upton-Lovel, aged 69 years.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 27 May 1799)*

On Sunday the 31<sup>st</sup> ult. died, in the 57<sup>th</sup> year of her age, Dionesia, the wife of Mr John Raxworthy, of Upton Lovell, in this county.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 8 February 1819)*

On the 17<sup>th</sup> inst. died, at an advanced age, Christopher Ingram, Esq. of Upton Lovell, in this county.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 27 September, 1824)*

Died – On Monday last, at the Rectory, Upton Lovell, after a very short illness, sincerely beloved and lamented by his family and all who knew him, John Wansborough, esq. of Nunney, Somerset, and late of Shrewton Lodge, in this county.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 28 November, 1833)*

Died – Jan. 6, at Weymouth, the Rev. William Roles, A.M., rector of Upton Lovell and Sharncot, Wilts.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 16 January, 1834)*

Died, on Thursday, Nov. 27, at Upton Lovell, Mr John Raxworthy, aged 73 years.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 1 December, 1834)*

Died, on Wednesday last, at Upton Lovell, in the 64<sup>th</sup> year of his age, Mr Roger Rebbeck, only surviving son of the late Thomas Rebbeck, of Knook, for many years distributor of the Salisbury and Winchester Journal and the Bath Chronicle.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 8 August, 1836)*

Died – June 13, after a few days illness, Louisa, wife of Thomas Raxworthy, esq. of Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette – Thursday 25 June, 1840)*

Died, on the 1<sup>st</sup> inst., after a long and lingering illness, Mr James Smith, of Upton Lovell, Wilts, farmer, in his 67<sup>th</sup> year, leaving a wife and twelve children to lament their loss. Surrounded by several members of his family, he quietly and calmly resigned his spirit into the hands of Him who gave it. He was highly respected and esteemed by all who knew him.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 7 February, 1842)*

Died, Nov. 27, at Charlton Wraxall, Somerset, aged 43(?) years, after a long illness, Frances, wife of Mr Thomas Bennett, and youngest daughter of the late Mr Raxworthy, of Upton Lovell.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 30 December, 1843)*

Died, on the 8<sup>th</sup> inst., after an illness of thirteen weeks, aged 22 years, Sarah, the only surviving daughter of Mr William Johnson, of the turnpike-gate, Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 16 March, 1844)*

Died, June 4, at Salisbury, after a long and lingering illness, Mary, wife of Mr J.A. Isworth, and third daughter of the late Mr James Smith, of Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 8 June, 1844)*

Died, July 19, At Trowbridge, after a short illness, and under very painful circumstances, sincerely beloved by her family and friends, Mrs Simons, in the 46<sup>th</sup> year of her age, eldest daughter of the late Mr James Smith, of Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 27 July, 1844)*

Died, at Langford, June 9, of rapid decline, to the grief of her family and friends, in her 28<sup>th</sup> year, Sarah, only daughter of Mr Robert Titt, of Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 13 June, 1846)*

Died, Feb. 18, aged 62 years, deeply regretted by her family and friends, Jane, wife of Mr Robert Titt, of Upton Lovell, Wilts.

*(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Saturday 27 February, 1847)*
