

## Harrod's Directory Extract 1865 Upton Lovell



Upton Lovell is a parish and village in Heytesbury hundred, Warminster union, South Wilts, about 5  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles S.E. from Warminster station, and 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  S.E. from Heytesbury.

The living is a rectory, yearly value £325, with residence, in the patronage of the Lord Chancellor; the Rev. William Gray is the incumbent.

Here is a small Free school.

Joseph Everett, esq., is lord of the manor. Superfine woollen cloths are manufactured here.

Population in 1861, 210; area in acres 1,399; rateable value, £2, 071 18s. 5d.;
