South Farmhouse

With Boundary Wall and Railings

Location: Manor Road, Upton Lovell, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 11th September, 1968

Detached house. Late C18. English garden wall bond brick, tiled roof with brick stacks. L-plan. Two-storey, 4-window front. Central 4-panelled door with fanlight and Tuscan stone portico, flanking canted bays with 12-pane sashes and 2-light casements to sides. First floor has four 2-light casements. Left return is partly rubble stone; casements. Rear has two canted bays, French windows and sashes, door with 6 fielded panels and segmental-headed blind window to left, 2-light cellar casement below, first floor has 16-pane sashes, 2-light casement and blind window. Wing to right has glazed doors, tripartite 12-pane sashes and casements.

Interior has original joinery. Limestone ashlar walls attached to front corners of house, chamfered rusticated end piers and front cast-iron spearhead railings with anthemion-decorated piers and single gate.
