FIRE

..... On Monday evening, another fire took place at Upton Lovell, near Warminster, by which two barns and a skilling and a wheat and a barley-rick, belonging to Mr Raxworthy, were destroyed. There is little doubt that it was an act of an incendiary.

At an early hour on Saturday morning last, a fire was discovered bursting forth from a granary, in the occupation of Jonathan Oliver, of Upton Lovell. It soon communicated to the dwelling-house, which was speedily destroyed.
