COMMITTED TO THE COUNTY GAOL, DEVIZES for the week ending July 7, 1874 Joseph Cooper, seven days for drunkenness, at Urchfont. **The Wiltshire Independent 9 July 1874**

1890

At Devizes Divisional Petty Sessions --- Eleanor Laver, for being found drunk at Urchfont on the 15th May, was ordered to pay costs, amounting to 4s. 6d. --- Defendant, who admitted the offence, said that it would not occur again, and that she was at the time overcome by trouble on account of her husband, who was awaiting his trial.
