Urchfont (Wedhampton)

1825

On Monday se'nnight a bull, the property of Mr Harrington, of Wedhampton, which had got from the field into the road at Lydeway, attacked the fore horse of a team belonging to Mr Stratton, of Seend, and gored the animal so dreadfully that it died in the spot. The middle horse would probably have shared the same fate, had not the driver procured assistance, and bear the furious animal off. **Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 11 August 1825**
