

## John Gibbs, Deceased

PURSUANT to 22nd and 23rd Vic., Cap. 35 Instituted *(inter alia).* "An Act to Relieve Trustees", all Creditors and other persons having any claims against the estate of JOHN GIBBS, late of Horpit, in the Parish of Wanborough, in the County of Wilts, Farmer, Deceased, who died on the 24th day of August 1879 (whose Will was proved in the Principle Registry of the Probate Division of Her Majesty's High Court of Justice, on the 3rd October 1879, by JOSEPH GIBBS, the younger, the Executor), are required to send in the particulars of their debts or claims to us, the solicitors to the Executor, by the 15th day of December 1879, after which time the Executor will distribute the assets of the said Deceased among the parties entitled thereto, having regard only to the claims and demands of which he shall then have had notice, and will not be liable for such assets, or any part thereof, to any person of whose debit or claim he shall not have had such notice.
