

In the Devizes Division of Wiltshire, Swindon and Highworth Union, County Court District and Petty Sessional Division of Swindon, and Diocese of Bristol, Wanborough is situated 3 miles from Swindon by the newly made road, 6 from Shrivenham Station (G.W.R), and 2½ from Chisledon Station (G.W.R). The parish is locally known by two divisions, Upper and Lower Wanborough. From south east to north west the parish is seven miles long, but in width it varies from only a half to one mile. The Church dedicated in the name of St. Andrew, is an ancient structure, and like Purton (there being only three such churches in England), is remarkable for having a square perpendicular tower (containing five bells) and detached spire intercepting the chancel and the nave. The living, a vicarage net value, £290, with residence, is in the gift of the Lord Chancellor. There is a small mission room at Foxhill. A convenient hall in Upper Wanborough is controlled by the Church Council. Social and athletic recreation is supplied by the Village Club. Its headquarters are at the village Hall – newly built in 1925. There are Wesleyan and Primitive Methodist Chapels in the parish, Mr. F. P. Goddard and Magdalen College. Oxford are Lords of the Manor and principal landowners. A bread charity is disbursed by the vicar and churchwardens annually, together with small cash gifts for widows. A coal charity is distributed to agricultural employees annually. The area is 4,513 acres; rateable value, £7,380; population in 1921, 882. Letters arrive from Stratton. There is a Money Order Office, Post Office Savings Bank and Telegraph Office and Public Telephone Call Office at Lower Wanborough open from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Post closes at 9.30 a.m. and 6.20 p.m. weekdays. The pillar box at Upper Wanborough is cleared at 9.20 a.m. and 6.10 p.m., and the box at Cross Roads, Lower Wanborough, at 9.35 a.m. and 6.25 p.m. The new box at Lotmead, Stratton Road, is cleared at 9.40 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. The Post Office is open from 8.30 a.m. to 10.a.m. For telegrams on Sunday.

NYTHE, 3 miles east from Swindon Station, and HORPIT, 4 miles east, are hamlets.

FOXHILL, 5 miles south west from Swindon, is also a hamlet. The letter box is cleared at 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. It is noted for its racing stables, with an important stud farm at King Edward Place, nearby.
