Thomas Henry Williams was brought up in custody, charged with **assaulting Sarah Titt**, on the 20th inst., at Warminster. - it appeared that a quarrel ensued between the parties, who are neighbours, during which the prisoner used filthy language towards the prosecutor, and struck her in the face, knocking her down. - sentenced to one month's hard labour.
