



St. Boniface Missionary College Festival 1890

The festival of this College was celebrated on the 12th inst. The proceedings commenced with an early celebration of the Holy Communion in the College Chapel, followed by matins at the Minster at noon, when the Rev. E. E. Dugmore, vicar of Parkstone, Dorset, preached a practical sermon from St. John xx., 21 and 22. After the service a luncheon took place in a marquee in the College Grounds. The Warden (the Rev. Sir J. E. Phillips, bart.) presided, the vice-chair being occupied by the Principal (the Rev. J. F. Welsh), and the company included the Bishop of Corea and a large number of clergy and friends of the College. Evensong was held at 6.15, and subsequently the members of the Minster Choir were entertained at supper.
