This is the last Will and Testament of me Elizabeth Fricker of Warminster in the County of Wilts Widow first I direct all my just debts funeral and testamentary expences to be fully paid and satisfied I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah fricker All my household Goods and ffurniture Plate Linen and China to and for her own absolute use and benefit Also I give unto my Grandson Edward Wheeler a Legacy or sum of fifty pounds to be paid and become a vested Interest in him on his attaining the age of twenty five years And as to all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my monies and securities for money whatsoever and of what nature or kind soever I give and bequeath the same and every part thereof unto and to be divided equally between and among my three Children William fricker Elizabeth Wife of Edmund Howell and Sarah fricker their Executors Administrators and Assigns as tenants in Common and not as joint tenants And I hereby make nominate constitute and appoint my said Daughter Sarah fricker whole and sole Executrix of this my Will hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament subscribed my name and affixed my seal this eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty four *Elizabeth Fricker*
