I Mary Bodman of Warminster in the County of Wilts Widow do hereby revoke and make Void all former and other Will and Wills Testament and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made And do Declare this to be my only last Will and Testament as follows (that is to say) First I Give unto my Cozen Anne Beal Daughter of my Uncle Joseph Beal the Sum of Ten pounds a Year during her Natural life to be paid by my Executrix hereinafter mentioned by half Yearly Payments Also all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my Moneys Goods Chattles and Effects and all other my Real and Personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever I Give Devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Bodman But in Case she shall happen to Dye before her Age of One and twenty Years Then and not otherwise I Give unto my Two Sisters Elizabeth Smith and Anne Braine the Sum of One thousand Pounds each And Lastly I do hereby make Nominate and Appoint my said Daughter Anne Bodman Sole and only Executrix of this my said last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Mary Bodman have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty Ninth day of August In the Year of our Lord 1759 Mary Bodman
