I William Adlam of Warminster in the County of Wilts Gentleman do hereby revoke and make void all and every Will and Wills Testament and Testaments by me at any Time heretofore made and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament which followeth that is to say first I will that my Debts and funeral Expences be paid and satisfied Also I give and bequeath to my Son in Law James Lucas and to Anne his Daughter the sum of one Guinea a piece to each of them to be paid to them respectively at the end of three Months next after my decease Lastly I give devise and bequeath to my Daughter in Law Betty Adlam my real Estate Lands Tenements which I have a power to give or dispose of and also all the rest residue and remainder of my Personal Estate Money Goods Chattels and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and I make nominate and appoint her the said Betty Adlam sole and only Executrix of this my said last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the twenty seventh Day of September in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and ffifty *William Adlam*
