In the Name of God Amen I William Shepard of Warminster in the County of Wilts Malster do hereby revoke all my former Wills and declare my last Will and Testament to be as followeth Imprimis I give to my Cousin James Mandrill one shilling of lawfull money of Great Britain Item I give to Mary the Daughter of Jasper Munday ffifty pounds of like lawfull mony Item I give to the said Jasper Munday ffifty pounds of like lawfull money Item I give to my Cousin William Yard Ten pounds of the like money Item I give to my Cousin Mary Millard Ten pounds of the like money Item I give to my Cousin John Yard ffifty pounds of the like money Item I give to John Turner Junr Ten pounds of the like lawfull money Item I give to my Aunt Mary Shepard Widow ten pounds of the like money Item all the rest residue and remainder of my Goods Chattells and credits I give and bequeath to my beloved friend John Dannell of Warminster aforesaid Malster whome I likewise constitute make

and Ordeine my only and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this seventh day of July annoque Dom 1719 and in the fifth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord King George (the mark of William Shepard) signed sealed and declared by the said William Shepard the Testator as his last Will and Testament in the Presence of us the Subscribers *John Shepard_ William Slade Junr*
