The new chapel erected in this place was opened yesterday, when a sermon was preached by the Rev. A. D. Cope, of Southampton. In the evening a public meeting was held in the chapel, and addresses were delivered by a number of gentlemen. Mr. Charles Gwyer, of Newton Park, Whiteparish, occupied the chair. The chapel which cost about £200, and which is in the Norman style, was designed by Mr. G. L. Young, of Salisbury, and the work was executed by Mr. E. S. Brown, of Fisherton.
