## *West Knoyle 1850-1899*



**1857**

Wilts Quarter Sessions - Wednesday William Coward, stealing a smock frock, the property of James Lloyd, at West Knoyle - seven years penal servitude, after a previous conviction. **Salisbury & Winchester Journal, Saturday, 04 July 1857**

**1866**

Hindon Petty Sessions Charles Morgan was brought up in custody, charged with night poaching at West Knoyle, on the 31st January, and sentenced to three months' imprisonment, and at the end of that period, to find sureties. **Western Gazette, Friday, 16 February 1866**

**1869**

Hindon Petty Sessions. John Riddick, labourer, of West Knoyle, brought up on remand, charged with leaving his wife and child chargeable to the Mere Union. Sentenced to 14 days' imprisonment. **Western Gazette, Friday, 22 January 1869**

**1871**

Hindon Petty Sessions. William Love was summoned by Mr. Godwin, of West Knoyle, for misconduct in service. Ordered to pay the costs and cautioned not to appear again. **Western Gazette, Friday, 18 August 1871**
