1838

Committed to The New Prison, Devizes. John Scott, for one month, for maliciously damaging a fence adjoining the dwelling-house of William Applegate, at Westbury Leigh. **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 22 February 1838**

1840

Benjamin Eyres, for stealing a coat and waistcoat, the property of James Brunker, at Westbury Leigh - six months hard labour. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 24 August 1840**

1841

At a Petty Sessions held at Warminster on Thursday last For Trial: John Webb, charged with having stolen apparel, the property of William Hiscocks of Westbury Leigh. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, 11 February 1841**
