1851 Census at Westbury

John Elkins, head, 33, cloth cutter, his wife Charlotte, 35, children, John H., 13, Caroline, 11, Mark, 8, Ruth, 6, Priscilla, 3, Paul, 1, and visitor, Ruth Elkins, 38. All were born at Chalford, Wilts.

1861 Census at Westbury

Charlotte Elkins, 42, widow, woollen cloth worker, children Mark, 19, Paul, 16, woolen cloth worker, Precila, 13, and ? Elkins, 18, (daughter). All born at Chalford, Wilts.

Paul A. Elkins

Son of John Elkins and Charlotte Roberts of Wiltshire, England. Born July 15, 1849, in England. Came to Utah 1868, working on railroad.

Paul married Mary Miller on December 26, 1870, at Salt Lake City (daughter of David Miller and Mary Hamilton of Ayrshire, Scotland), who was born April 28, 1852.
