This is the last Will and Testament of me Susanna Swaine late of Dauntsey in the County of Wilts and now of Westport in the same County Widow I give and bequeath unto Francis West of Seagry in the said County of Wilts Esquire the Sum of Ten Pounds I give and bequeath unto John Garlick with whom I now dwell the Sum of ffive Pounds and unto Elizabeth Wife of the said John Garlick the like Sum of ffive Pounds And also unto Susanna Evans Daughter of Simon Evans of Burtonhill in the Parish of Malmesbury in the County of Wilts aforesaid the like Sum of ffive Pounds to be paid to the said Simon Evans In Trust for the use and benefit of his said Daughter Susanna All which said Legacies I will and direct shall be paid by and out of my Residuary Effects by my Executrix herein after named within one Year next after my decease I give and bequeath unto the said Simon Evans All and singular my Household Goods ffurniture and Utensils which are now in his possession at Burtonhill aforesaid except my Bed Curtains Vallens and other ffurniture thereto belonging And from and after Payment of the above Legacies and my just Debts and ffuneral Expences I give and bequeath all and singular my said Bed and my Cloaths Linen and Wearing Apparel Money and Security for Monies and all arrears of Interest due and owing to me at the time of my decease and other Personal Effects and property whatsoever and wheresoever unto my two Sisters Jane Mason of Little Saffron Hill in the City of London Widow and Margaret White of the City of London Spinster their Exors Admors and Assigns to be equally divided between them share and share alike And Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my said Sister Jane Mason Executrix of this last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the Testatrix the said Susanna Swaine have hereunto set my hand and Seal the sixteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight *Susanna Swaine*
