Bailes

Sacred to the memory of the Reverend John Bailes of Hilperton, Clerk, who died 7th June 1842 in his 70th year, leaving a wife and a family of nine children who lament his loss.

He was perpetual curate of Hilperton and Whaddon for nearly 35 years and during the whole of that period was absent from his duty only a month.

Also to William Horne, son of the above, who died May 21st 1834, aged 1 year.

Also in memory of Mary Ann, second daughter of the late Reverend John Bailes, who died September 5th 1857, aged 40 years.

Also of Susanna, widow of the late Reverend John Bailes who died June 13th 1864, aged 77 years.
