Salisbury, County Petty Sessions - Tuesday Present: J. H. Jacob, Esq. (Chairman), Earl Nelson, T. E. Fowle, Esq., E. Hinxman, Esq., and A. F. Paxton, Esq. William Elkins, a lad aged 13 years, was charged with assaulting and misconducting himself towards Miss Harriet Gay, at Whiteparish.
