



CORONERS INQUESTS



Whiteparish 1850-1899

1872

An inquest was held here on Saturday, before Mr R. M. Wilson, on the body of a boy 12 years old, named Wm Alford. The boy had been sent with a cart and two horses to the farm, for a load of swedes. He was afterwards found lying under the wheels of the cart in a rut, quite dead. There was no evidence to show how he came into the rut. Verdict: "Accidental death." **Western Gazette 23 February 1872**
