



Death of Mrs. Weeks

On Wednesday, the death occurred of Mrs. Annie Weeks, wife of Mr. H. Weeks, at the age of 68. Mrs. Weeks was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Payne of Goodmayes, Essex and before her marriage lived in London. For many years she was children's nurse for Mrs. Rogers, of Rainscombe Park. Thirty two years ago, she became the second wife of Mr. H. Weeks, the whole of her married life being spent at Oare. During that time, when her health permitted, she did much good service in the village as sick nurse. She was the mother of two children - a son Mr. Desmond Weeks, of Milton Lilbourne and Mrs. David Amor of Pewsey. She was greatly attached to the Methodist cause, regularly attending the services at Oare, as long as her health permitted. The funeral service in the Chapel on Saturday was conducted by the Rev. J. B. Chapman, the Circuit Minister, the interment being in the Oare churchyard. The mourners were: Mr. H. Weeks (the widower), Mrs. David Amor (daughter) and Mr. D. Amor (son-in-law). Mr. D. Weeks (son), was prevented by illness, from attending. Other friends and relatives present included Mrs. Flood, Mrs. Longson, Miss Fletcher, Miss Henderson, Mrs. Houghton, Mrs. Marsh (The Crescent, Pewsey) and Mrs. Hiscock.
