



Coroner's Inquest Report

Inquest of William Moore 1872

SUDDEN DEATH

An inquest was held before Mr. Wilson, coroner, on Monday, on the body of William Moore, aged 47 years, one of the under-guardians at Wilton House, who was found dead in his bed on Sunday morning.

From the evidence it appeared that on Saturday night, about ten o'clock, the deceased went to bed, having made no complaint of illness that day, but he had on previous occasions complained of feeling faint in the morning when he came home to breakfast.

Dr. Good, surgeon, was sent for, and he was of the opinion that death resulted from disease of the heart.

A verdict to that effect was returned.
